Silent for ninety years, reborn. These are the early casks. Annandale was founded in the 1830s in Annan, in the far south of the Lowlands, and in its earlier life was connected to the great blending house of John Walker & Sons. This cask comes to the platform at £34 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £4,357 and a spirit cost of £10.95 per 70cl bottle before tax. The maturation. Approximately 7 years are already done, so part of the hold is behind you.

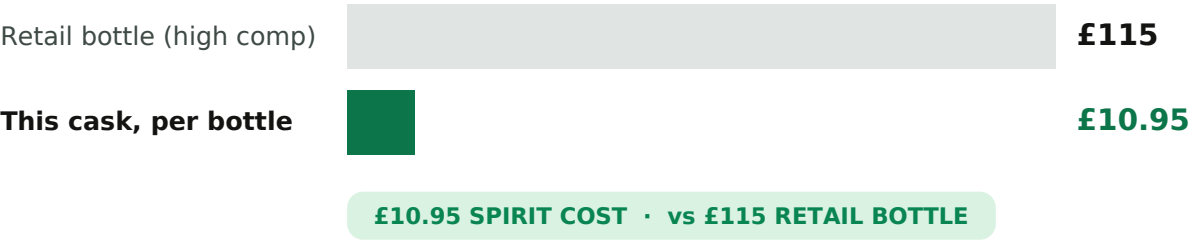
The entry economics. At 398 bottles per cask the spirit cost is £10.95 per 70cl bottle before tax, the level you enter at.

Pricing & Outlook

What you pay against what the bottles sell for, and where the value can go.

This cask comes to the platform at £34 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £4,357. That works out to 398 bottles at a spirit cost of £10.95 per 70cl bottle before tax. The bar below sets that figure against comparable Annandale bottlings selling at retail today, which reach £115 per bottle.



The bottles behind that comparison, live at retail today:

Comparables run from £70 to £115 per bottle. That spread is the room a cask has to grow into over a longer hold.

Platform Precedent

Clients have already bought and exited this exact product on the platform.

This is not a new, untested line. 1 client / 2 casks of this exact product have already completed a full buy-and-exit cycle on Decant Index. Across those exits the average realised return was 25.3% over an average hold of 51 months.



Reading the data

05 / THE DISTILLERY

The Distillery

Silent for ninety years, reborn. These are the early casks.

Annandale was founded in the 1830s in Annan, in the far south of the Lowlands, and in its earlier life was connected to the great blending house of John Walker & Sons. It fell silent around 1918 and closed shortly after, joining the long list of lost Scottish distilleries, until Professor David Thomson bought the site in 2007 and undertook a painstaking, expensive restoration. Spirit flowed again in 2014, after nearly a century of silence.

Annandale now produces both peated and unpeated single malt, and its early-production casks, like this one, are exactly the kind of foundational stock that defines a revived distillery's first chapter. The local microclimate has been reported to mature spirit notably well. For a distillery with deep history and a fresh start, the earliest casks carry a particular significance.

The cask offered here is a ex-bourbon fill, approximately 7 years matured, held in HMRC-bonded storage at Alloa in Scotland. It comes to the platform at £34 per litre of alcohol, roughly £4,357 per cask, a spirit cost of £10.95 per 70cl bottle before tax.

A genuine revival story

Annandale was silent for around ninety years before its careful restoration. A historic name brought back to life is exactly the kind of narrative collectors are drawn to.

These are casks from the distillery's first chapter since reopening, foundational stock with a significance that later, higher-volume years will not carry.
