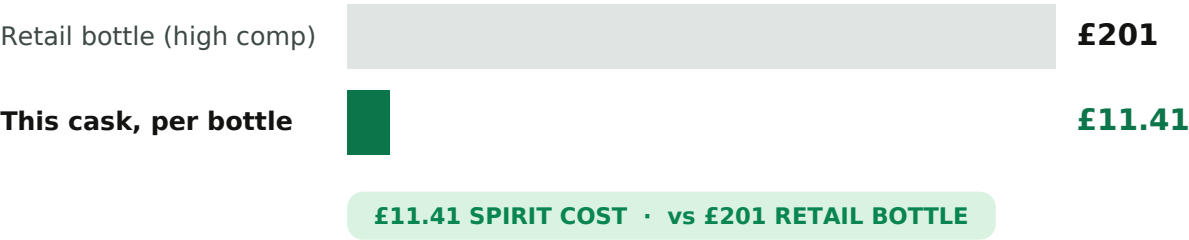

Pricing & Outlook

What you pay against what the bottles sell for, and where the value can go.

This cask comes to the platform at £35 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £5,284. That works out to 463 bottles at a spirit cost of £11.41 per 70cl bottle before tax. The bar below sets that figure against comparable Bruichladdich bottlings selling at retail today, which reach £201 per bottle.



The bottles behind that comparison, live at retail today:

Comparables run from £144 to £201 per bottle. That spread is the room a cask has to grow into over a longer hold.

05 / THE DISTILLERY

The Distillery

Islay's restless innovator, home of Octomore and The Botanist.

Bruichladdich was built in 1881 by the Harvey brothers on the shore of Loch Indaal, on the Rhinns peninsula in the west of Islay, using then-modern Victorian equipment that is in many cases still in use today. After a chequered century and a spell mothballed in the 1990s, it was famously resurrected in 2001 by a group of private investors with master distiller Jim McEwan at the helm, and has been owned by Rémy Cointreau since 2012.

Bruichladdich has become one of the most talked-about names in modern Scotch through sheer force of personality. It produces unpeated Bruichladdich, the heavily peated Port Charlotte, and Octomore, widely recognised as the most heavily peated single malt in the world. It also makes The Botanist, one of the best-known craft gins. The distillery is fiercely focused on barley provenance and Islay terroir, with much of its barley grown on the island itself.

The cask offered here is a ex-bourbon / ex-rioja / ex-sherry / rum fill, a new fill, held in HMRC-bonded storage at Alloa in Scotland. It comes to the platform at £35 per litre of alcohol, roughly £5,284 per cask, a spirit cost of £11.41 per 70cl bottle before tax.
