WHY THIS CASK IS UNUSUAL AT THIS PRICE POINT

- The name.** A working Highland distillery inside a historic cotton mill. Deanston sits on the banks of the River Teith near Doune, in a building that began life as a cotton mill in 1785, designed in part by the inventor Richard Arkwright's circle.
- The maturation.** Approximately 27 years are already done, so part of the hold is behind you.
- The entry economics.** At 329 bottles per cask the spirit cost is £96.57 per 70cl bottle before tax, the level you enter at.

Pricing & Outlook

What you pay against what the bottles sell for, and where the value can go.

This cask comes to the platform at £300 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £31,770. That works out to 329 bottles at a spirit cost of £96.57 per 70cl bottle before tax. The bar below sets that figure against comparable Deanston bottlings selling at retail today, which reach £110 per bottle.

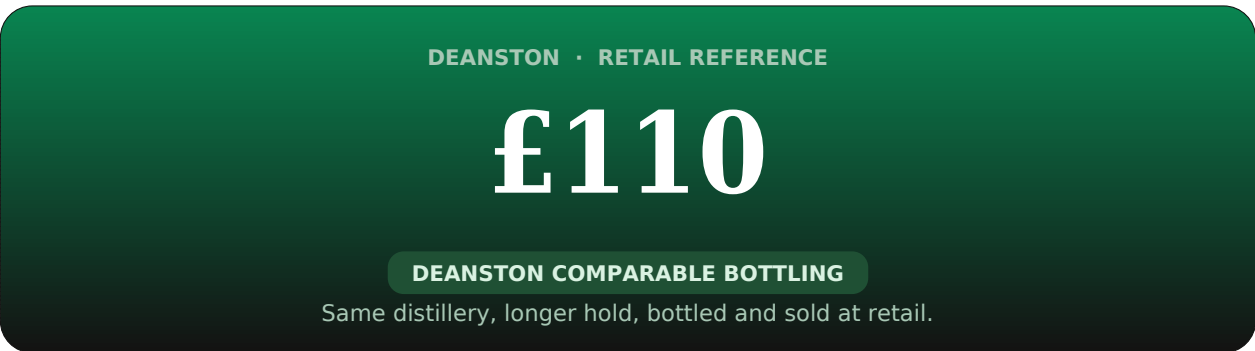


The bottles behind that comparison, live at retail today:

Deanston mid comparable	Hedonism Wines	£110.00

Comparables run from £71 to £110 per bottle. That spread is the room a cask has to grow into over a longer hold.

05 / THE DISTILLERY

The Distillery

A working Highland distillery inside a historic cotton mill.

Deanston sits on the banks of the River Teith near Doune, in a building that began life as a cotton mill in 1785, designed in part by the inventor Richard Arkwright's circle. The mill was converted to a distillery in the mid-1960s, and it remains one of the few distilleries that generates its own hydro-electric power from the river that runs alongside it. The vast vaulted weaving shed now serves as a naturally cool maturation warehouse.

Deanston takes a deliberately traditional, hands-on approach, with open-top mash tuns and a focus on unchill-filtered, natural-presentation whisky. It has built a strong reputation for quality and value, sitting today alongside Bunnahabhain and Tobermory in the same ownership group. On the Decant platform it has been one of the strongest-moving names this year.

The cask offered here is a ex-red wine fill, approximately 27 years matured, held in HMRC-bonded storage at Alloa in Scotland. It comes to the platform at £300 per litre of alcohol, roughly £31,770 per cask, a spirit cost of £96.57 per 70cl bottle before tax.
