Single malt brought back to the city of Glasgow. The Glasgow Distillery was founded in 2015, marking the return of single malt production to the city of Glasgow after a long absence. This cask comes to the platform at £26 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £1,778 and a spirit cost of £8.39 per 70cl bottle before tax. WHY THIS CASK IS UNUSUAL AT THIS PRICE POINT

The name. Single malt brought back to the city of Glasgow. The Glasgow Distillery was founded in 2015, marking the return of single malt production to the city of Glasgow after a long absence.

The maturation. Approximately 5 years are already done, so part of the hold is behind you.

The entry economics. At 212 bottles per cask the spirit cost is £8.39 per 70cl bottle before tax, the level you enter at.

Pricing & Outlook

What you pay against what the bottles sell for, and where the value can go.

This cask comes to the platform at £26 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £1,778. That works out to 212 bottles at a spirit cost of £8.39 per 70cl bottle before tax. The bar below sets that figure against comparable Glasgow bottlings selling at retail today, which reach £70 per bottle.

Comparables run from £60 to £70 per bottle. That spread is the room a cask has to grow into over a longer hold.

The outlook



Not a forecast. The bottle reference simply shows the ceiling that long holds of this distillery move toward, value at exit depends on demand and condition.

04 / PLATFORM PRECEDENT

Platform Precedent

Clients have already bought and exited this exact product on the platform.

This is not a new, untested line. 7 clients / 39 casks of this exact product have already completed a full buy-and-exit cycle on Decant Index. Across those exits the average realised return was 31.0% over an average hold of 28 months.



Reading the data

These figures are realised, not modelled: they reflect the difference between what clients paid and what they received on exit for this same product. They are historic and specific to those casks, and do not guarantee the same outcome for stock bought today.

The Distillery

Single malt brought back to the city of Glasgow.

The Glasgow Distillery was founded in 2015, marking the return of single malt production to the city of Glasgow after a long absence. It is part of a wave of new urban Scottish distilleries reconnecting whisky-making with the cities that built the industry's trade, and it has earned strong critical reviews for the quality of its spirit in a short space of time.

The distillery produces a range of styles, including unpeated, peated and even a triple-distilled expression, showing real ambition and versatility for a young operation. As a modern craft distillery with a clear city identity and a growing reputation, Glasgow represents the newer, fast-rising end of the Scotch market.

The cask offered here is a ex-bourbon fill, approximately 5 years matured, held in HMRC-bonded storage at Alloa in Scotland. It comes to the platform at £26 per litre of alcohol, roughly £1,778 per cask, a spirit cost of £8.39 per 70cl bottle before tax.
