The maturation. Approximately 7 years are already done, so part of the hold is behind you.

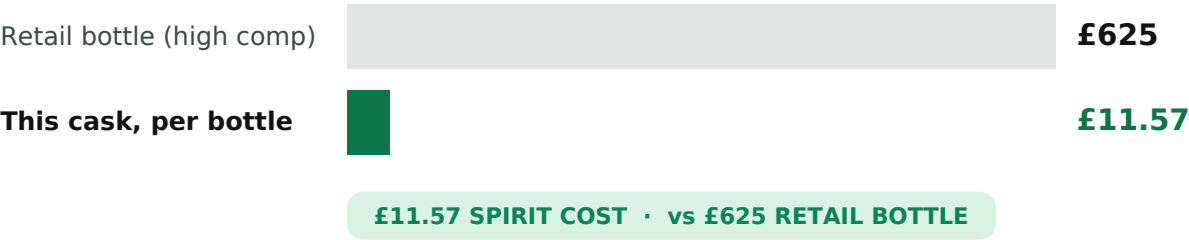
The entry economics. At 391 bottles per cask the spirit cost is £11.57 per 70cl bottle before tax, the level you enter at.

Pricing & Outlook

What you pay against what the bottles sell for, and where the value can go.

This cask comes to the platform at £36 per litre of alcohol, a total of approximately £4,523. That works out to 391 bottles at a spirit cost of £11.57 per 70cl bottle before tax. The bar below sets that figure against comparable Glenrothes bottlings selling at retail today, which reach £625 per bottle.



The bottles behind that comparison, live at retail today:

Comparables run from £121 to £625 per bottle. That spread is the room a cask has to grow into over a longer hold.

04 / PLATFORM PRECEDENT

Platform Precedent

Clients have already bought and exited this exact product on the platform.

This is not a new, untested line. 16 clients / 21 casks of this exact product have already completed a full buy-and-exit cycle on Decant Index. Across those exits the average realised return was 11.9% over an average hold of 23 months.



Reading the data

05 / THE DISTILLERY

The Distillery

The blender's favourite, and Macallan's sherried neighbour.

The Glenrothes was built in Rothes in the heart of Speyside, with its first spirit running on 28 December 1879, the night of the Tay Bridge disaster. Its founding syndicate also owned the nearby Macallan, and the two distilleries sit only a few minutes apart, sharing a deep affinity for sherry-cask maturation. Glenrothes is today part of the Edrington Group, Macallan's parent.

Glenrothes has long been one of the most important malts for blenders, forming a backbone of famous names such as Cutty Sark and The Famous Grouse. Its single-malt identity is built around elegant, fruity spirit and a strong commitment to sherry oak, expressed through its vintage releases and the sherry-led Soleo Collection. It is a connoisseur's distillery that has quietly earned the respect of the people who make whisky for a living.

The cask offered here is a ex-bourbon fill, approximately 7 years matured, held in HMRC-bonded storage at Alloa in Scotland. It comes to the platform at £36 per litre of alcohol, roughly £4,523 per cask, a spirit cost of £11.57 per 70cl bottle before tax.

Glenrothes is a malt that blenders specifically seek out for quality, which tells you a great deal about the spirit. That professional regard is a quieter but durable form of demand.
